Costel is pastor of Emmanuel Church in Balti, Moldova. Costel planted the church in 2006 and the Lord has grown the church to 350. The Lord has used the church to plant in another 11 villages.

Paul has been UK Director of France Mission since 2010. Prior to that, he was Associate Professor and Head of French at the University of Exeter. The year 2024 marks 50 years since the establishment of France Mission.

Dr Beryl D'Souza-Vali leads the multi-faceted Good Shepherd Healthcare Initiative (GSHI), the healthcare division of Good Shepherd Church of India. Bob Fu

Dr Fu is one of the world leading voices for the persecuted faithful and human rights in China and author of *God's Double Agent*. He is the founder of China Aid, established in 2002, an international NGO with a mission to advance religious freedom and rule of law for all in China.



Fred Hand

Fred Hand is the Chairman and Co-Founder of Waakisa Ministries where he has worked for over 20 years. Waakisa's work is focused on their Youth Centre in Uganda where a team of trained Ugandan staff provide a safe environment for girls and their babies, and equip them with vital life skills and training.



Pete Hansen

Pete Hansen is an award-winning independent filmmaker with over four decades of experience. His international documentary projects include fourteen episodes of *Dispatches from the Front* and the feature-length *Jesus in Athens*.



Andrew Maybin

Andrew is currently serving the Lord with the Faith Mission Gospel Truck throughout Ireland. Alongside his wife Carolyn, they lead a team of volunteers who are passionate in reaching people with the gospel. Their work is varied, from county shows and fairs, to Bible clubs and family fun days.

David Meredith is Mission Director for the Free Church of Scotland. He is involved in supporting evangelism, church planting and revitalisation both internationally and in Scotland. David was previously senior minister at Smithton Free Church in Inverness for thirty years.
