Avril

For over 15 years, Avril has been privileged to serve in Christian cross-culture work, working alongside diverse communities both at home and overseas. Most recently, she has been involved in establishing an organisation called Acacia Path.



Igor Bandura

Igor is the vice-president for international affairs, Baptist Union of Ukraine; pastor, missiologist, expert in the field of global partnerships of church and missions. Bandura represents a grassroots network of more than 2,000 churches across Ukraine. Since 2000, he has been a partner of Slavic Gospel Association UK which is celebrating their 75th Anniversary.



Voddie Baucham

Voddie Baucham is a husband, father, grandfather, former pastor, church planter, best-selling author, and professor. He was the founding Dean of the School of Divinity at the African Christian University in Lusaka, Zambia. He is also a founding faculty member of the Institute of Public Theology.



Beredi Dusan

Beredi came to Christ when he was 20 and was healed from alcoholism. Today he is the lead pastor of the Protestant Christian Fellowship Novi Sad, the largest Serbian evangelical church in Serbia. He represents Ten Europe who are celebrating their 60th anniversary.

**Jonny Farrell**

Jonny serves as the Northern Ireland Director of Stand by Me, a ministry dedicated to rescuing children from difficult circumstances and providing them with the care, love and attention they need to thrive. They operate in six different countries around the world.

**'Jean-Pierre & Jayne'**

Jean-Pierre and Jayne have been serving in North Africa for over 15 years, involved in church-planting, discipling new believers, medical work and supporting local social action projects. They have a passion for combining the verbal proclamation of God's Word with social action in everything they do.

**Iulian Mangalagiu**

Iulian is Regional Director for the Child Evangelism Fellowship (CEF) of Europe. He co-led Hope for Ukraine, delivering 120,000 gospel backpacks and 8 million evangelistic booklets to children across 19 countries.

Josh McCance is the church planter and pastor of Balbriggan Presbyterian Church, launched in 2020. Balbriggan is one of the most ethnically diverse towns in Ireland with around 25 nationalities worshipping together.

Beth serves with AsiaLink, sharing with women and children throughout Ireland about some of the amazing things that God is doing in Asia. Alongside her husband, Henry, she enjoys working with partners throughout many countries in Asia and values the opportunity to learn from different cultures and communities.
